## Enbridge helps fuel quality of life for millions of North Americans.

Enbridge is North America's largest energy infrastructure company, and is a continental leader in diversified energy delivery – connecting people to the energy they need, safely and responsibly.

As a transporter of energy, Enbridge operates the world's longest crude oil and liquids transportation system. We safely deliver an average of 3 million barrels a day – or 30% of the crude produced in North America. We're also a North American leader in natural gas gathering, transportation, processing and storage, moving about 20% of the natural gas consumed in the U.S.

As a distributor of energy, Enbridge is Canada's largest natural gas distribution provider, serving about 15 million people in Ontario and Quebec through 3.9 million residential, commercial, institutional and industrial meter connections.

As a generator of energy, Enbridge has committed more than US\$6 billion (C\$8 billion) in capital in wind, solar, geothermal, power transmission, waste heat recovery, and a host of emerging technology projects. Collectively, these renewable energy projects (in operation or under construction) have the capacity to generate 2,175 megawatts (MW) net, of zero-emission energy.

That's enough, based on net generation figures, to meet the electricity needs of about 967,000 homes. We believe that working towards lower-impact energy solutions is in everyone's best interest. Our portfolio of renewable energy projects is diversified and growing.

Safety is the very foundation of Enbridge's operations. Over the past six years, we've engaged in the most extensive inspection and preventative maintenance program in the history of the North American pipeline industry. We believe all incidents can be prevented, and we're working hard – through 24/7/365 monitoring, comprehensive prevention strategies, and the use of leading-edge technology – to keep our system as safe as possible.

Enbridge has a workforce of more than 12,000 people, primarily in the U.S. and Canada. Enbridge was named to the Thomson Reuters Top 100 Global Energy Leaders in 2018; we've been selected to Bloomberg's Gender Equality Index four years running, most recently in 2022; and we have been ranked among Canada's Top 100 Employers 19 times, most recently in 2022.
